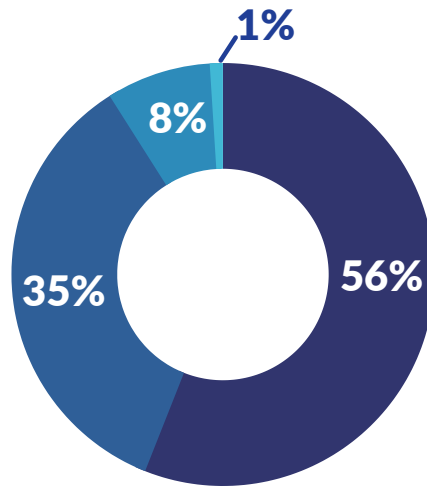
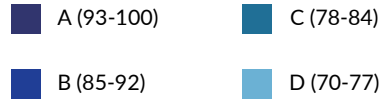

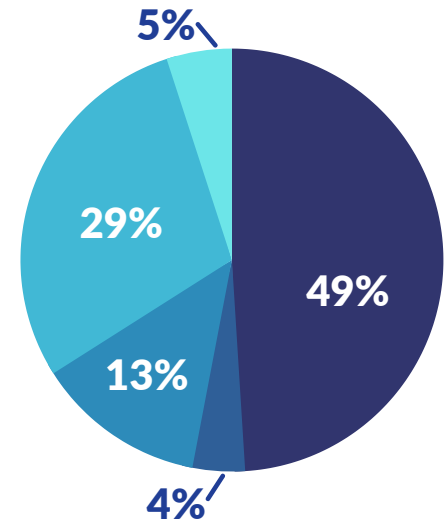
## SCHOOL YEAR

## EXTRACURRICULARS/SPORTS

Our students also collaborate in a school-wide fund-raising activity known as Empty Bowls, an international initiative that sells student ceramic artwork to help stop hunger in Honduras. The money for this cause is donated to Hospital Marías, malnourished patients. Students also participate in international events and conferences such as HACIA Democracy, Model United Nations, LEAD and GIN Conferences. AST offers the opportunity for athletic competition in four varsity sports: Track & Field, basketball, soccer and volleyball. AST teams compete nationally and internationally.
