MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Degrees from English-speaking native countries preferred (US/Canada/UK, etc)
 - Valid international teaching credential and/or local Honduran equivalent
- Two years of teaching experience in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics at the high school level
 - Familiarity with Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB) preferred

BASIC DESCRIPTION

This posting is not for a specific vacancy but generally expresses the needs of the institution. A specific position would be determined through the interview process and be framed around a candidate's specific strengths.

Being a STEM teacher necessitates preparing students for success with Common Core (math), NGSS (science), ISTE (technology), and/or IB standards (science/math). For dedicated educators seeking college preparatory exposure, IB Certification and/or experience working in an IB school, this is an ideal position and career opportunity. As an institution which values project-based learning, the ability to offer hands-on experience in these subject areas is crucial. Furthermore, educators who have experience doing extensive science labs, leading students through scientific inquiry, mathematics competitions [UPN, ABSH, etc], and robotics [Lego League, VEX, etc] lessons or competitions will be preferred. Additionally, the academic teams (i.e. science, computer science, mathematics) meet on a weekly basis in order to work on key skills and grow professionally. As a school that positions all students for success, working with counselors and student services educators is also essential. This involves implementing needed accommodations as specified in 504 accommodations as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and/or Individualized Education Plans as defined under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

The teacher will need to secure Google Level One certification within their 1st year of employment at AST as all our staff are certified and we are a Google Reference school. The teacher will need to operate within the myriad of technological platforms that our school uses for grade reporting (PowerSchool), assignment delivery/collection (Schoology), curriculum mapping (Atlas Rubicon), Measures of Academic Progress tools (NWEA MAP) and a variety of on-demand instructional tools that are part of the pedagogical culture (Quizizz, FlipGrid, IXL, etc).
