WELCOME TO AST

The American School of Tegucigalpa offers three different diplomas: the Honduran Bachillerato, the High School Diploma and the International Baccalaureate Diploma. AST has been a Cognia accredited school since 1962, reinforcing our great standards and quality education. The Honduran Ministry of Education grants the national degree of Bachillerato to students who comply with additional credits and 160 hours of community service. The school year consists of 182 days divided into 2 semesters. The first semester begins in August and the second semester in January. Grades are issued quarterly. The school day begins at 7:30 a.m. and ends at 2:30 p.m.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

73% of the senior class is enrolled in all three diplomas and/or certificates offered: the Honduran Bachillerato, High School and the International Baccalaureate Diploma. IB Certificates are earned by students who choose to take up to five IB courses. AST uses the Bridge U platform to support our students' career pathways and application process. Parchment service is used for reporting official documents to universities not listed in the common application.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND OUTCOMES CO-CURRICULAR OFFERINGS

AST has an extensive co-curricular program for high school students, based around clubs. Sports are offered in Junior Varsity and Varsity athletic teams that have the opportunity for competition and formative sports program in Track & Field, Basketball, Soccer and Volleyball during entire school year and summer as co-curricular activity. Students collaborate in fund-raising activities to sponsor 12 community service organizations. Our students join clubs that are linked to international conferences and tournaments as Honors Band, Model United Nations (MUN), National Honor Society, Robotics, Operation Smile, TedEd Club, Global Issues Network (GIN), Global Vision International (GVI), STEAM and Knowledge Bowl.

GRADUATION SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

A Service Learning requirement serves to instill all Bachillerato students with a sense of community and understanding of our responsibilities as global citizens. Service experiences should be meaningful, authentic and provide opportunities for learning. Students document their ongoing commitment to service with reflections posted in the CAS portfolio, and a final thesis for the Honduran Ministry of Education.

2025 AVERAGE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) SCORES BY SUBJECT

- 78% of AST's International Baccalaureate Full Diploma Candidates, in the class of 2025, earned the International Baccalaureate Diploma; the world average was 81% in the May, 2025 session.
- 35% of AST's students, in the class of 2025, were International Baccalaureate Full Diploma Candidates.
- 26% of AST students, in the class of 2025, earned three diplomas: International Baccalaureate Diploma, Honduran Bachillerato, and The American School Diploma.
- 98% of AST's International Baccalaureate Diploma program Candidates, who earned the IB Diploma - earned the International Baccalaureate Bi-Lingual Diploma; the world average for this was 27% in 2025.
- 56% of AST's students, in the class of 2025, completed three or more International Baccalaureate Diploma program courses.

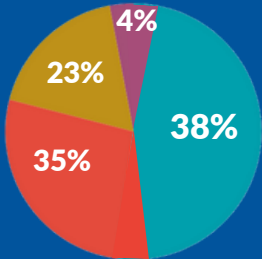

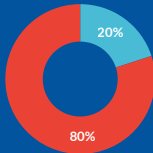
